### **Goals/Doelstelling:**

De Stichting vormt een werkgemeenschap voor evangelisatie en sociaal-maatschappelijke activiteiten, die ten dienste staan van het koninkrijk van God. Vanuit de Christelijke grondslag en identiteit verricht de stichting activiteiten en werkzaamheden ten behoeve van jongeren, ongeacht hun geloof, geslacht, ras, kleur, opleiding of anderszins.

This is derived from the YfCI International mission: As part of the body of Christ, to see every young person in every people group and in every nation have the opportunity to make an informed decision to be a follower of Jesus Christ and become a part of a local church.

### **Annual report 2018 YFC EMENA**

In EMENA we are working in 34 nations. This is what we did to reach our Strategic goals in 2018:

#### 1. Building an Area Team and Prayer

We have a team with six participants, visiting the nations, organizing training and support for developing new nations. We have also staff available now for coordination Member Care for our ND's.

Prayer is the foundation for our work. We collaborate with the Wakeup Deborah YFCI ministry (WUD). The book 'Faith, Prayer & Teenagers' is now translated in seven different languages. The vision is that everywhere people are praying for the kids.

#### 2. Building Sustainability

We were training Boards, new Key Staff and new National Directors and Youth Leaders. Also organizing coaching with a focus on Russian speaking coaches. We built sustainability by using the strong work from neighbouring nations. We are doing some pilots with Business as Mission too. In the Middle East we organize Training of The Trainers (TTT). We equip them to be a trainer in Youth Ministry in their own nation. They train the youth leaders and pastors to connect in a relevant way with a new generation. YFC in some nations are also doing research which results in new ministry-models which you can find on the websites of the different nations with YFC ministry. There's a lot of different ministry going on in all the nations.

#### Ad. 3. Building Bridges

We are building bridges by sending teams and connect nations with each other.

As EMENA we share best practices, like Superwoman, a ministry model for young women. At the moment we this ministry model already in eight different nations in the Area. The materials are translated and contextualized. We share also our resources for Churches and Schoolwork.

#### A.4. Building ONE YFC

We organized Regional conferences for Central-, Western- and Eastern Europe and the Middle East. We also had our Area Council in Czech Republic with about 90 National Directors and key staff, from different EMENA nations.

The impact of this is strengthening one YFC Family and equip them to work on the strategy for the Area and their nation. Each month we send an EMENA newsletter to all nations in EMENA.

#### Ad.5. Building YFC in New nations.

We are exploring work in the Middle East. In the Balkan Region we made two teams with volunteers in Macedonia and Kosovo. We have already YFC in Sweden and we are also exploring to start in other nations in Scandinavia.

#### **Plans for 2020**

We will continue to work on our strategic goals:

1. Building a strong Area-team and Prayer
2. Building Sustainability
3. Building Bridges between nations
4. Building ONE YFC
5. Building YFC in new nations.

To make this possible we organize different meetings with ND's from the different regions and are working on making plans on how to develop these five main goals.

We will have our international General Assembly in the Netherlands and expect at least 700 people from all over the world including a Track for Young Leaders.
